The 2004 Elections: Tools to Reclaim Our Courts and Our Constitution

1. **"The Constitutionalist Manifesto: A Declaration of Independence from Judicial Supremacy"**: A summary of the basic principles for which we Constitutionalist must be fighting in the 2004 elections and the Culture War beyond. These principles are foundational to all our efforts and to the other action tools included in this packet.
2. **"Candidate Questionnaire: The Constitution and the Courts"**: A unique questionnaire which is appropriate for candidates for virtually any office. Since 2000, we have seen how officials from a county election board to the U. S. Congress may be involved in constitutional/judicial struggles. The attached questionnaire requires no candidate to comment on a particular court case. Rather, the focus is on candidates' underlying philosophies of the Constitution and culture. Candidates' responses indicate whether they support our effort to free America from judicial supremacy.
3. **"Omnibus Party Resolution on the Constitution and the Courts"**: A set of practical actions that can, and should, be taken immediately to help free America from judicial supremacy. This non-partisan resolution can be used by any party and should be included in both state and national party platforms. Most of the measures advocated have already been included in Congressional initiatives to restore constitutional supremacy in America.
