Revive the Constitution! Reviving the Constitution Action Plan for the Elections of 2012 and Beyond

A. Congress

1. Shall deny federal courts the power to hear challenges to:

- Acknowledgements of God on public property and in official utterances such as the Pledge of Allegiance;
- Federal and state actions that protect marriage as traditionally defined
- Programs in which creation-science is given objective, credible treatment
- Laws protecting the unborn child (“unborn child” defined as in the federal Unborn Victims of Violence Act)

2. Shall refuse to recognize, fund, or otherwise enforce court decisions that:

- Prohibit acknowledgements of God on public property and in official utterances such as the Pledge of Allegiance
- Define and/or protect as “marriage” any relationship other than marriage as traditionally defined in America
- Invalidate objective, credible presentations of creation-science
- Negatively affect the unborn child (“unborn child” defined as in the federal Unborn Victims of Violence Act)
- Are based totally or in part on foreign or international law, except for the classical English Common Law and the Judeo-Christian worldview

3. Shall attach to each of the above measures a provision that **denies federal courts the power to hear challenges** to that particular measure.

B. The President shall nominate, and the Senate shall confirm, **judicial nominees who clearly and demonstrably adhere to Constitutionalist principles**

C. State Legislatures shall:

- Pass resolutions** urging national officials to pursue the above actions
- Take appropriate measures to protect states** from federal encroachments
