3. How is the Security and Prosperity Partnership being implemented?
4. How does a NAFTA Superhighway fit into these plans, and who would benefit?
5. How do treaties encroach on U.S. sovereignty — such as: treaties on trade, the law of the sea, women, and the rights of the child?
6. How does foreign trade cheat Americans? Should we be concerned about outsourcing American jobs?
7. Is George Washington's famous warning about foreign alliances relevant in the 21st century?
9. Is globalism good or bad for American law and economy?
10. What can we do about U.S. trade agreements that discriminate against Americans?
11. Should we build an anti-missile defense, as Reagan called for?
12. What is so important about the unique American patent system?
