## 2012 Congressional Candidate Questionnaire

*(You are welcome to call Eagle Forum for clarification of any questions.)*

### YES NO A. TAXES, GOVERNMENT SPENDING, AND REGULATION

- 1. Will you vote NO on all tax increases?
- 2. Will you vote to make the 2001, 2003 and 2010 tax cuts permanent?
- 3. Will you vote to reduce the marriage penalty for **both** one-earner and two-earner couples?
- 4. Will you vote to abolish the death tax **without** passing a new tax (called “carryover basis”) on the sale of inherited property?
- 5. Will you vote to repeal the ban on Edison light bulbs?
- 6. Will you vote to oppose a national energy tax?
- 7. Will you vote to preserve workers’ rights to a secret ballot in union elections?
- 8. Will you vote against all funding for the National Endowment for the Arts?
- 9. Will you vote to defund the Legal Services Corporation?
- 10. Will you vote to defund the Violence Against Women Act, widely known as “feminist pork”?
- 11. Will you oppose all funding for ACORN and its affiliated organizations?

### YES NO B. NATIONAL SECURITY, FOREIGN POLICY, AND SOVEREIGNTY

- 1. Will you vote to fund a National Missile Defense system (long-range and short-range)?
- 2. Will you vote against using taxpayer funds for UN “peacekeeping” or “nation-building” missions where U.S. national security is not threatened?
- 3. Will you oppose any effort to put U.S. troops under foreign commanders?
- 4. Will you oppose efforts to extend or make permanent policies that place female soldiers in or embedded with direct ground combat units that attack the enemy, such as the infantry, or in Special Operations Forces and submarines?
- 5. Will you vote to preserve separate training for male and female Marines, and restore it in the Army?
- 6. Will you support the 1993 law about homosexuals in the military (Section 654, Title 10, U.S.C.)?
- 7. Will you oppose the United Nations Convention (Treaty) on the Law of the Sea?
- 8. Will you actively oppose all UN attempts to impose taxes on international travel or transactions, and will you vote to withdraw from the UN if it imposes any tax?
- 9. Will you vote against any treaty or legislation that requires the United States to reduce its energy consumption, such as a Global Warming Treaty or Cap and Trade legislation?
- 10. Will you oppose the United Nations Convention (Treaty) on the Rights of the Child?
- 11. Will you oppose the UN Convention (Treaty) on the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW) (an “Equal Rights Amendment” enforced by the UN)?

### YES NO C. BORDER SECURITY AND IMMIGRATION

- 1. Will you vote against any form of amnesty for illegal aliens?
- 2. Will you vote against any guest-worker program (which is amnesty in disguise)?
- 3. Will you vote to repeal Ted Kennedy’s Diversity Visa Lottery, which admits 50,000 aliens per year, mostly from non-Western countries including countries that sponsor terrorism?
- 4. Will you vote to close our borders to illegal aliens and illegal drugs by whatever means necessary, including physical and electronic fences and National Guard troops?

- 5. Will you vote to require employers to use E-Verify to check employees' Social Security numbers?
- 6. Will you vote against any Federal law that preempts state or local efforts to enforce federal immigration law within their own borders?
- 7. Will you vote to prohibit Mexican trucks from access to U.S. highways and roads?
- 8. Will you oppose the State Department's "totalization agreement" with Mexico which allows illegal aliens to count unlawful U.S. work towards qualifying for Social Security benefits?
- 9. Will you vote to limit the federal requirement that hospital emergency rooms give free medical care to illegal aliens (an unfunded mandate bankrupting hospitals)?
- 10. Will you vote to revoke the citizenship of naturalized citizens who betray their oath of U.S. citizenship by claiming "dual citizenship" with their **native** country?
- 11. Will you vote to stop giving U.S. citizenship to babies ("anchor babies") born to illegal aliens? (The 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment does not apply because illegal aliens are "subject to the jurisdiction" of their native countries.)
- 12. Will you vote to impose financial penalties on states that: (check all that apply)
  - issue driver's licenses to illegal aliens?
  - accept foreign-issued cards, such as the *matricula consular*, as acceptable IDs?
  - give lower in-state tuition to illegal aliens (in violation of current federal law)?
  - refuse to cooperate with immigration officials in identifying illegal aliens?
- 13. Will you vote to overturn Clinton's Executive Order 13166, which compels recipients of tax dollars (such as doctors and hospitals) to offer services in foreign languages?
- 14. Will you support federal legislation to clean up voter registration lists and require proper voter ID in federal elections?
- 15. Since only U.S. citizens are allowed to vote, will you support legislation requiring that aliens counted in the 2010 census may not be used for purposes of apportionment or redistricting?
- 16. Will you support making English our official language (as 30 states have done)?

**YES NO D. LIFE**

- 1. Do you oppose the judge-invented notion that abortion is a constitutional right?
- 2. Do you support legislation to restore legal protection to unborn babies?
- 3. Will you support the confirmation of judges only if they respect the sanctity of human life at every stage?
- 4. Will you support a human life amendment to the Constitution?
- 5. Will you vote to prohibit taxpayer funding of **all** abortions?
- 6. Will you vote to continue prohibition of abortion services on military bases and in D.C.?
- 7. Will you vote to cut off federal funds for Planned Parenthood and any other organization that performs abortions, both in the U.S. and abroad (even if they use money from other sources)?
- 8. Will you vote to require parental consent before a minor can receive services at federally-funded Title X family planning clinics?
- 9. Will you support legislation that prohibits research that involves killing human embryos?
- 10. Will you support legislation to completely ban all forms of human cloning?
- 11. Will you oppose the use of federal funds to distribute abortion-causing drugs, such as RU-486?
- 12. Will you oppose any change in the pro-life plank in the Republican Platform, which has been virtually unchanged since 1984, namely: "The unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed."

**YES NO E. EDUCATION AND PARENTAL RIGHTS**

- 1. Will you oppose national testing, national standards, and federal control of curriculum through the Common Core Standards?
- 2. Will you vote against funding for universal mental health screening in public schools?
- 3. Will you vote for federal school appropriations to require informed, written parental consent for curricula, surveys, classes or books that may be privacy-invading or offensive to religion or conscience?
- 4. Will you support the right of all fit parents to the care, custody, and control of the upbringing of their children, even if parents are divorced?
- 5. Will you support federal funding for abstinence-until-marriage education instead of for explicit sex-education programs, school-based clinics, and the distribution of contraceptives in schools?

- 6. Will you vote to end federal funding of so-called bilingual education (teaching immigrant children in their native languages) which the voters of CA, AZ, and MA have rejected?
- 7. Will you vote to deny federal funds to schools that force children to use psychotropic drugs?
- 8. Will you vote to deny federal funds to schools that require students to be vaccinated for HPV?

**YES NO F. FAMILY, HEALTH CARE, AND WELFARE**

- 1. Will you vote to protect the Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA)?
- 2. Will vote to repeal ObamaCare and deny funding to enforce any of its provisions?
- 3. Recognizing that family care is best for children and the nation, will you oppose any plan for federal financing or regulation of child care?
- 4. Will you vote to reform the health insurance system by a combination of —
  - phasing out the incentives for employers to provide company-owned health insurance?
  - encouraging individuals to own high-deductible plans with health savings accounts?
- 5. Will you vote to prohibit persons who receive benefits from vaccine manufacturers from serving on government panels that approve vaccines?
- 6. Will you vote to require states and health care providers to prohibit euthanasia and assisted suicide as a condition of participation in Medicaid and Medicare programs?
- 7. Will you vote to continue the prohibition of a Federal “unique health care identifier”?

**YES NO G. CONSTITUTIONAL AND PRIVACY**

- 1. Will you oppose any effort to revive the Equal Rights Amendment and any legislation that implies that the ERA, which expired in 1982, is still viable?
- 2. Will you oppose efforts to call a convention for proposing amendments to the U.S. Constitution?
- 3. Will you support legislation for Congress to use its Article III power vote to deny jurisdiction to the federal courts over areas where we don’t trust them, namely, the definition of marriage, the Pledge of Allegiance, the Ten Commandments, the Cross on veterans’ memorials, and the Boy Scouts?
- 4. Will you vote to prohibit the federal courts from hearing challenges to the federal Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA) or similar state laws respecting the definition of marriage?
- 5. Will you vote against any bill that limits inventors’ constitutional right to their inventions?
- 6. Will you oppose federal hate crimes laws?
- 7. Will you vote to prohibit the expansion or creation of federal databases that monitor the activities of law-abiding Americans, such as bank deposits, cell phone usage, health care, immunization records, travel, schoolchildren, and lawful gun purchases? (Databases of felons, terrorists, and aliens are OK.)
- 8. Will you oppose all efforts to repeal the federal ban on internet gambling?
- 9. Will you vote against any legislation to help Puerto Rico to become a state?
- 10. Will you vote against any legislation to pretend that the District of Columbia is a state or entitled to a state’s representation in Congress?
