Married Couple Penalties

January 9, Phyllis talked with David Usher about how the government health care plans discriminate against married couples and are just another way for the federal government to redistribute wealth. David is a scholar and an activist who is a twenty-year pro-family advocate. He's working to establish a conservative organization that focuses on marriage.

Many welfare programs encourage marriage avoidance and other self-destructive choices. He said that "money drives human behavior," so for example, since the economic downturn, more low-income couples are seeking divorces or deciding not

to get married because they get more financial assistance from the government.

Phyllis explained that legislators intentionally favor unmarried couples because that increases the likelihood that both adults would take jobs, which means more federal tax revenue. Phyllis pointed out that one legislative assistant admitted in an interview, "you just have to know what your goals are."

Unmarried women are one of the most reliable groups of supporters of the Democratic party, and many liberal feminists see this attack on marriage as a form of "social justice." However, feminists are usually not motivated by helping women, but rather by eliminating marriage.

Phyllis pointed out that the health care bill is only one of many federal bills that punishes individuals for getting married, including a service charge on cell phones, which goes to a government program that gives other people free cell phones.
